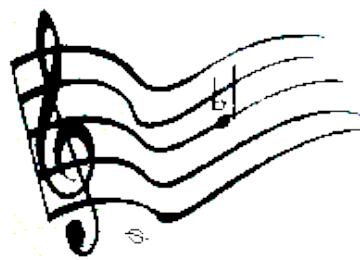
TERM 2 STUDENT CONCERTS
